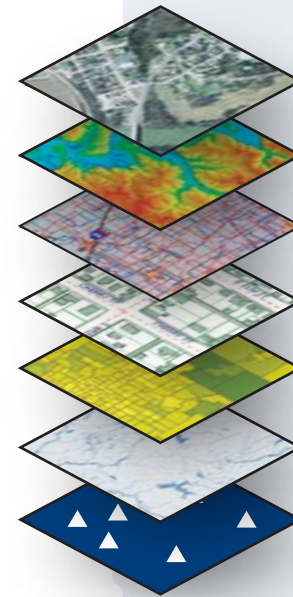

What is the IndianaMap?

The IndianaMap is a statewide digital map for Indiana. It brings together information from around the state into a single location accessible to everyone.

History of the IndianaMap

The web portal was started at the Indiana Geological Survey nine years ago with Bernardin, Lochmueller & Associates as INDOT's I-69 Corridor project

IGS/INDOT expanded portal coverage from southwest Indiana to the entire state, creating the "GIS Atlas for Indiana"

IGIC developed and promoted GIS framework data standards, and created the 2005 Statewide Orthophotography project with C-TASC

UITS & IGS provide GIS data storage, distribution, and viewing services for the statewide orthophotography

Indiana Code 4-23-7.3 is passed in 2007

The 2008 IGIC/IGS partnership re-brands the GIS Atlas for Indiana as the IndianaMap

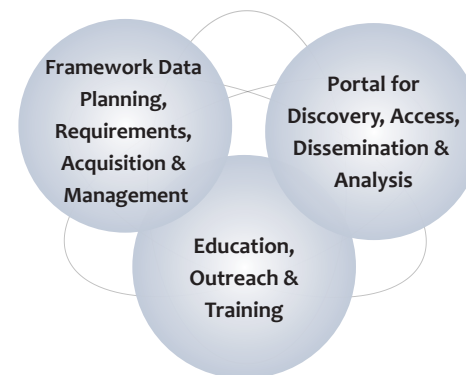
Reasons to Support the IndianaMap

Hoosiers Stand to Gain

IndianaMap (www.indianamap.org) supports hundreds of local, regional and statewide projects each year. The initial investment of \$8.5 million in the IndianaMap supports over 200-times its value in projects and operations - with 90% of users indicating they could not do their projects without it. As is evident from this study, the IndianaMap proves a good investment by saving tax-payer dollars and providing an information infrastructure that benefits all Hoosiers.

In 2007, the Indiana General Assembly passed IC 4-23-7.3 Indiana GIS Mapping Standards that formally defines “framework data” as common electronic map information for a geographic area—the core data sets of the IndianaMap. This law established the State of Indiana Geographic Information Office, institutionalized the role of the Indiana Geographic Information Council, and created the Indiana Mapping Data and Standards Fund (although to date no funds have been appropriated).
